The School has sent over 400 boys to the NDA and an almost equal number of boys have joined the Armed Forces as officers through IMA/ OTA/ NAVAC/ AFA.

Class Room Rules

- 1. All cadets to reach classrooms in time.
- 2. Visit toilets during breaks only.
- 3. No furniture to be taken out of the class rooms.
- 4. Maintain cleanliness at all times.
- Do not remain in school building during odd hours unauthorized.
- 6. Do not make noise or play in classroom.
- 7. Throw paper, wrappers and other trash in dustbin only.
- Conserve electricity. Switch off lights and fans when not required.
- Maintain all text books/notebooks neatly and keep them up to date.

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Laboratory Rules

- 1. Follow the instructions given by the teachers/ lab staff.
- 2. Any breakage or loss must be reported immediately.
- The cadets should come prepared with requisite theoretical knowledge to undertake experiment in the laboratory.
- Cadets should come to laboratory with complete practical record and observation note book.
- 5. All cadets are to be regular for practical classes.
- All work to be done in the presence of concerned teacher/ lab staff.
- 7. Cadets should not try to touch or taste any chemical as they can be harmful.

Rules of School Library

- Maintain silence in the school library.
- ny book lost/ torn must be informed to the librarian immediately and the book lost by the borrower shall have to be replaced within 15 days from the date of loss by the borrower.
- Each borrower is supposed to examine the condition of the book when it is issued and has to ensure that the damage if any, is mentioned in the loan register.
- While returning the book, the borrower will ensure that the date of return is correctly entered and each entry is signed by the librarian.
- A borrower from whom fine or some other recovery is long overdue will be debarred from borrowing books from the library.

- Stealing of books/ magazines from the school library is a serious offence. If a student is caught while stealing book/ magazine from the library he/ she will have to pay double the cost of the book in addition to other disciplinary action.

- 6. Share what you can with others. Above all, remember these are precious days in your life. Friendships and impressions

- Though poor but senior in age also deserves courtesy, kindness and respect from you.

- 15. Observe Mess etiquettes and conduct yourself with decorum and dignity at all times.
- 16. Respect your seniors and be courteous to them.
- 17. Take care of your habits and environment.
- Remember "YOU ARE BEING GROOMED TO BECOME AN OFFICER AND ABOVE ALL AN IDEAL CITIZEN OF THE COUNTRY".
